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Drop-in clinics

Drop-in clinics are **not** to be done on a permanent basis. Students will only go to these clinics when they require assistance or to catch up. Rolls are kept so that we know students are in the right place at the right time.

- **Maths Clinic:** every day at lunch in GLC1(KMB) for students to gain help with their Maths studies. This is open to students in all years.
- **Art Clinic:** open on Fridays at lunch in K413 for students to catch up on their works. This is open to students in all years.

Other opportunities

- **The Duke of Edinburgh's Award** is an internationally recognised self-development program for young people over the age of 13 and 9 months. It is non-competitive and encourages young people to set and achieve goals at a level appropriate to their development. There are four sections that you will complete to achieve the award: community service, skill development, physical recreation and expedition (hiking, canoeing or both).

All sections provide an opportunity for you to acquire and develop skills and encourage self-esteem, which will help you become more confident members of the community. There are three award levels: Bronze, Silver and Gold. You can complete one level or gradually complete all three. There are several students at the school who have completed their Gold Awards.

The Duke of Edinburgh's Award offers a fantastic opportunity for you to become active in your community and to complete fun activities with your friends. The award is open to students in Years 9, 10, 11 and 12. Please see Mr Vose in the PDHPE department.
